**RULE DISCUSSION**

**Tab 1     Rule 64B17-4.001, F.A.C.**

At the February board meeting, the board conducted a rule workshop to discuss the changes to the education requirements for Physical Therapists Assistants. The rule has been placed on the agenda for further consideration of revising the rule to comply with Section 486.102(3)(a), F.S.

The Board ensued with further discussion on rule language. The Board feels an applicant can petition for a Declaratory Statement or have their application come before the Board to determine if their education meets the requirements for licensure.

**MOTION:** After discussion, Dr. Tasso made a motion to propose the following draft language of Rule 64B17-4.001(3)(a), F.A.C.

(3) Education,

(a) Has received a degree as a physical therapist assistant from an institution as specified by the statute ~~that, has been approved for the training of~~

physical therapist assistants by the Commission on Accreditation for Physical Therapy Education (CAPTE), at the time of graduation,

The motion was seconded by Dr. Petraglia and carried 4/0.

The board analyzed and considered the impact of the rule change.

**MOTION:** Dr. Petraglia made a motion to find the proposed revisions do not have an adverse impact on small businesses. The motion was seconded by Dr. Quillen and carried 4/0.

**MOTION:** Dr. Tasso made a motion to find the proposed revisions will not be likely to directly or indirectly increase regulatory costs to any entity (including government) in excess of \$200,000 in the aggregate in Florida within 1 year after the implementation of the rule. The motion was seconded by Ms. Pettie and carried 4/0.

### **NEW BUSINESS**

#### **Tab 7 Dry Needling**

The Florida Physical Therapy Association (FPTA) requested the opportunity to appear before the board to discuss dry needling. Representatives were present and provided information on the procedure of dry needling for the board's consideration and to initiate discussion as to whether rule development related thereto would benefit the profession.

Anna Small, Esq. from Allen Dell Attorneys At Law, whom represents the Florida Physical Therapy Association, addressed the Board for possible rulemaking to determine that dry needling is not in fact acupuncture.

Rob Stanborough, Physical Therapist and instructor at University of St. Augustine, stated fifteen countries and thirty three states in the United States allow dry needling in their practice act.

Ellen Teeter, President of the Florida State Oriental Medical Association addressed the board. She feels rulemaking is conflicting with the statute. She also has concerns for patient safety due to lack of training.

Hong Jian He, President of the Florida Acupuncture Association, addressed the board and stated performing acupuncture takes extensive training. She reiterated that during the performance of dry needling, acupuncture needles will be required.

Lynn Thomas, Secretary of the Florida State Oriental Medical Association expressed her concerns. She feels all professions should come together as a team. If dry needling is allowed within the scope of physical therapy, this will exclude acupuncture for becoming a member of the team. She also feels businesses of acupuncture will be negatively impacted.

Board members discussed if rulemaking is within their authority due to statutory regulations.

Dr. Petraglia addressed the board and stated that determination will be concluded with what the board interprets from the statute and if they feel dry needling is in fact acupuncture.

Dr. Gina Musolino, stated the Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy and the Florida Physical Therapy Association do not define dry needling as acupuncture.

Upon further discussion Dr. Petraglia requested dry needling to be placed on the next agenda for continued discussion.

### **Tab 8 Determination of Rule Impact**

Determination of Rule Impact is language used routinely in certain rulemaking notices that are published in the Florida Administrative Register.

“The Agency has determined that this will not have an adverse impact on small business or likely increase directly or indirectly regulatory costs in excess of \$200,000 in the aggregate within one year after the implementation of the rule. A SERC has not been prepared by the agency.

The Agency has determined that the proposed rule is not expected to require legislative ratification based on the statement of estimated regulatory costs or if no SERC is required, the information expressly relied upon and described herein: During discussion of the economic impact of this rule at its Board meeting, the Board, based upon the expertise and experience of its members, determined that a Statement of Estimated Regulatory Costs (SERC) was not necessary and that the rule will not require ratification by the Legislature. No person or interested party submitted additional information regarding the economic impact at that time.”

The SERC checklist will allow more Board member discussion to the impact of the rules at the Board meeting.

**MOTION:** After discussion, Dr. Petraglia made a motion to conditionally approve Mr. Weber's application for licensure and to certify him to sit for the Florida Laws and Rules Exam. Mr. Weber must fulfill the following conditions:

- Within six (6) months must obtain medical malpractice insurance, a supervising physical therapist, and a passing score on the Florida laws and rules exam. If noncompliant he will be required to reappear before the Board. Once fulfilled, a conditional license shall be granted.
- Within one year of the Final Order date must complete two (2) live courses of prevention of medical malpractice continuing education. Dr. Tasso is delegated to review and approve the courses.
- Direct supervision by a board approved physical therapist for one (1) year. Dr. Quillen is delegated to approve the supervisor.
- Supervising physical therapist must cosign all records.

The motion was seconded by Ms. Pettie and carried 4/0.

Board staff conducted a web search and found supporting documentation via public websites for arrests not disclosed on his application. Dr. Petraglia addressed this with Mr. Jahns. Board Counsel asked Mr. Jahns how many DUI convictions he's received to which Mr. Jahns stated three.

After discussion at the May meeting, The Board approved the application for licensure and authorized Mr. Jahns to sit for the Florida Laws and Rules Exam. Upon successful completion of a PRN evaluation and compliance with their recommendation, licensure could be granted. Applicant had 30 days to contact PRN, 90 days to schedule an evaluation and 120 days to comply or licensure would be denied. Board staff was delegated to approve licensure once all terms are complete.

Mr. Jahns failed to comply with PRN's recommendations and his previous application was administratively denied.

Mr. Jahns has submitted a new licensure application for the Board to consider.

**MOTION:** After discussion, Ms. Pettie made a motion to approve the application for licensure and authorize Mr. Jahns to sit for the Florida Laws and Rules Exam. Upon successful completion of a PRN evaluation and compliance with their recommendation, licensure is granted.
