RULE DISCUSSION AND/OR DEVELOPMENT

1. Dry Needling

On February 8, 2018, the Board drafted and voted on rule language for Rule 64B176.008, F.A.C., Minimum Standards of Practice for Dry Needling in the Practice of Physical Therapy. Subsequent to the Rule Notice publication, the following were received for Board review.

- Letter from the Joint Administrative Procedures Committee (JAPC)
- Request for Public Hearing from the Florida Oriental Medical Association
- Public Comments
- Request for a Special Committee with the Board of Acupuncture

Request for a Special Committee with the Board of Acupuncture:

The Board reviewed the request from the Board of Acupuncture.

MOTION: After discussion, Dr. Tasso made a motion to decline the request for a special committee to be formed with the Board of Acupuncture regarding dry needling. The motion was seconded by Dr. Petraglia and carried 5/0.

Letter from the Joint Administrative Procedures Committee (JAPC)

Board Counsel provided a DRAFT response for the Board's review.

After review of the letter, the Board provided suggestions to Board Counsel.

MOTION: Dr. Tasso made a motion to direct Board Counsel to submit a notice a change to, 64B17-6.008(2)(b) to include:

Proposed paragraph (2)(b), "Selection and safe handling of needles and other apparatus and equipment, including hygiene and infection control pursuant to relevant standards of the United States Centers for Disease Control and Prevention or the United States Occupational Safety and Health Administration; and" was modified to read:

(2)(b) Prior to commencement of clinical training, every approved course of study and tutorial program shall provide training in clean needle technique and universal precautions for preventing the transmission of bloodborne pathogens and other infectious diseases, including, for example, HIV/AIDS, hepatitis, staphylococcus, and tuberculosis.

The motion was seconded by Dr. Donald and carried 5/0.

Full rule text below:

64B17-6.008 Minimum Standards of Practice for Dry Needling in the Practice of Physical Therapy

(1) For the purpose of this rule, "dry needling" is a skilled technique based on western medical concepts performed by a physical therapist using apparatus or equipment of filiform needles to penetrate the skin and/or underlying tissues to affect change in body structures and functions for the evaluation and management of neuromusculoskeletal conditions, pain, movement impairments, and disability.

(2) The minimum standards of practice for dry needling in the practice of physical therapy shall include competence demonstrated by successful completion of education that includes the subject areas listed in the following paragraphs, and that is accredited, sponsored, or approved by the Commission on Accreditation in Physical Therapy Education, the American Physical Therapy Association, the Florida Physical Therapy Association, the Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy, or any branch of the United States Armed Forces:

(a) Evidence-based instruction on the theory of dry needling practice; and

(b) Prior to commencement of clinical training, every approved course of study and tutorial program shall provide training in clean needle technique and universal precautions for preventing the transmission of bloodborne pathogens and other infectious diseases, including, for example, HIV/AIDS, hepatitis, staphylococcus, and tuberculosis; and

(c) Dry needling indications and contraindications; and

(d) Anatomical review for safety and effectiveness as it applies to dry needling; and

(e) Psychomotor skills needed to physically perform dry needling; and

(f) Postintervention care, including an adverse response or emergency.

(3) The education shall include a face-to-face component with interaction with the course instructor and an in-person examination of cognitive and psychomotor skills related to dry needling.

(4) A physical therapist who performs or offers to perform dry needling shall supply the Department, upon request, with written documentation of his or her competence to perform dry needling.

(5) A physical therapist shall not delegate the practice of dry needling to a physical therapist assistant, unlicensed personnel, or any other person who is not a physical therapist.

MOTION FOR BOARD'S FINAL ORDER BY HEARING NOT INVOLVING DISPUTED ISSUES OF MATERIAL FACT

1. **Jennifer Karen Larson, PT 24390**
(Case No. 2017-00146)
(PCP- Tasso, Candela, Watson)

Dr. Donald stated that Ms. Larson is a former student of hers; however, she was able to remain objective in the case and did not need to recuse herself.

Respondent was not present nor represented by counsel.

Mr. Wilson summarized the case for the Board. Respondent was charged with the following violations: **Count I:** 456.072 (1) (c), Florida Statutes (2008-2010), being convicted or found guilty of, or entering a plea of nolo contendere to regardless of adjudication, a crime in any jurisdiction which relates to the practice. **Count II:** 456.072 (1) (c), Florida Statutes (2011-2012), crimes related to the practice. **Count III:** 456.072 (1) (x), Florida Statutes (2008), for failing to report to the Board. **Count IV:** 456.072 (1) (x), Florida Statutes (2010), failing to report to the Board. **Count V:** 456.072 (1) (x), Florida Statutes (2010), failing to report to the Board. **Count VI:** 456.072 (1) (x), Florida Statutes (2012), failing to report to the Board.

MOTION: Dr. Petraglia made a motion to find that the Respondent was properly served and requested a formal hearing. The motion was seconded by Mr. Chenoweth and carried 4/0.

MOTION: Dr. Petraglia made a motion to adopt the findings of fact set forth in the administrative complaint. The motion was seconded by Mr. Chenoweth and carried 4/0.
