Definition of Voting and Alternate Delegates

The FSBPT Delegate Assembly consists of Delegates elected by its member boards. Each member board is entitled to one Delegate. Each Delegate shall have the right to attend, speak, make motions, nominate, and vote. No Federation officer or director may serve as a Delegate. The Alternate Delegate is elected by the member board to be its representative to the Delegate Assembly in the event that the Delegate cannot or does not attend the meeting.

Requirements for Designating Voting and Alternate Delegates

- The member board must elect its Voting and Alternate Delegates.
- Voting and Alternate Delegates can be members or administrators of the member board.
- Credentials for Delegates shall include demographic data, verification of election from the member board and a disclaimer relevant to potential conflict of interest.
- Either the chair or administrator of the member board may credential the delegates.

Attendees: All voting delegates, alternate delegates, and selected administrators must attend. All jurisdiction board members and staff are eligible to attend.

Cost, Travel, and Registration: The cost of travel, hotel, meals, and meeting registration fees are covered by FSBPT in 2022 for “funded attendees.” All other attendees are self-funded. Registration fees will be communicated separately. Information about registering online will be provided during the summer. DISCIPLINARY PROCEEDINGS

MOTION FOR SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

- 1. Jason Balajadia, PT
(Case No. 2020-36119)
(PCP- Pabian, Tasso and Petraglia)**

Respondent was present and represented by counsel Rickey Strong, Esq.

Dr. Pabian was recused due to participation in the probable cause panel.

Ms. Shideler summarized the case for the Board. Respondent was charged with the following violation: **Count I:** 486.125 (1)(b) Florida Statutes (2020), subjects a physical therapist to discipline for committing fraud in the practice of physical therapy or deceit in obtaining a license as a physical therapist or as a physical therapist assistant. **Count II:** 486.125 (1)(i) Florida Statutes (2020), Making or filing a report or record which the licensee knows to be false. Such reports or records shall include only those which are signed in the capacity of a physical therapist.

MOTION: After discussion, Mr. Chenoweth made a motion to accept the settlement agreement and impose the following penalties:

- \$5,000 fine to be paid in one (1) year.
- Costs of \$2,000 to be paid within one (1) year.
- 10 hours of Continuing Education in Record Keeping and Ethics within ninety (90) days.
- Probation of license for one (1) year from the filing of the Final Order. Review of 25% once a quarter with ride along for 8 separate patients.
- Respondent shall sign an agreement to practice only under the indirect monitoring of a Physical Therapist who is fully licensed under Chapter 486, Florida Statutes, and is approved by the Board Chair.

The motion was seconded by Dr. Donald and carried 4/0.

MOTION FOR BOARD'S FINAL ORDER BY DETERMINATION OF WAIVER

2. Jennifer S. Meadows, PT (Case No. 2021-08026) (PCP- Koenig, Watson and Petraglia)

Respondent was not present nor represented by counsel.

Dr. Koenig was recused due to participation in the probable cause panel.

Ms. Shidler summarized the case for the Board. Respondent was charged with the following violation: **Count I:** 456.072 (1)(aa), Florida Statutes (2020) subjects a physical therapist to discipline for testing positive for any drug, as defined in s. 112.0455, on any confirmed preemployment or employer ordered drug screening when the practitioner does not have a lawful prescription and legitimate medical reason for using the drug.

MOTION: Dr. Donald made a motion to accept the investigative report into evidence. The motion was seconded by Dr. Pabian and carried 4/0.

MOTION: Dr. Donald made a motion to find that the Respondent was properly served and waived the right to a formal hearing. The motion was seconded by Dr. Pabian and carried 4/0.

MOTION: Dr. Donald made a motion to adopt the findings of fact as set forth in the Administrative Complaint. The motion was seconded by Dr. Pabian and carried 4/0.

MOTION: Dr. Donald made a motion to adopt the conclusions of law as set forth in the Administrative Complaint and find that this constitutes a violation of the Chapters 486 and 456, Florida Statutes. The motion was seconded by Dr. Pabian and carried 4/0.

MOTION: After discussion, Mr. Chenoweth made a motion to impose the following penalties:

- \$500 fine to be paid within 1 year.
- License to be suspended until respondent contacts the Florida Professionals Resource Network (PRN) within 30 days, undergoes an evaluation coordinated by PRN within 60 days of the filing of the Order and if recommended, comply with any and all terms or conditions imposed by PRN within 90 days of the filing of the Order as a result of said evaluation.

Respondent was charged with the following violation: **Count I:** 456.072 (1)(c), Florida Statutes (2020) subjects a physical therapist to discipline for being convicted or found guilty of or entering a plea of guilty or nolo contendere to, regardless of adjudication, a crime in any jurisdiction which relates to the practice of, or the ability to practice, a licensee's profession. **Count II:** 456.072 (1)(x), Florida Statutes (2020) subjects a physical therapist to discipline for failing to report to the board, or the department if there is no board, in writing within 30 days after the licensee has been convicted or found guilty of, or entered a plea of nolo contendere to, regardless of adjudication, a crime in any jurisdiction. Convictions, findings, adjudications, and pleas entered into prior to the enactment of this paragraph must be reported in writing to the board, or department if there is no board, on or before October 1, 1999.

MOTION: Mr. Chenoweth made a motion to accept the investigative report into evidence. The motion was seconded by Dr. Donald and carried 4/0.

MOTION: Mr. Chenoweth made a motion to find that the Respondent was properly served and waived the right to a formal hearing. The motion was seconded by Dr. Donald and carried 4/0.

Mr. Perez Rubio is requesting the Board to direct FCCPT to evaluate his credentials with “with no MINREX and MINSAP verification,” **OR** to accept a credentialing evaluation done by another entity that did not require original {verified} transcripts.

Board staff received a petition for waiver of rule 28-104.002., on December 1, 2021.

FCCPT documents must state that the documents came directly from the university.

MOTION: After discussion, Mr. Chenoweth made a motion to approve Mr. Perez Rubio’s petition for waiver of rule 28-104.002, F.A.C. and accept a FCCPT evaluation that deems his education equivalent within one (1) year or application will be denied. The motion was seconded Dr. Kleponis and carried 5/0.

The Board discussed and approved all future meetings going to one day with Discipline and Personal appearances starting on Friday and administrative proceedings to be completed in the afternoon after personal business is completed.
