2. Bryan M. Downs, PTA (Case No. 2018-26938) (PCP- N/A)

Respondent was charged with the following violation: **Count I:** 456.072 (1)(aa), Florida Statutes (2020) subjects a physical therapist to discipline for testing positive for any drug, as defined in s. 112.0455, on any confirmed preemployment or employer ordered drug screening when the practitioner does not have a lawful prescription and legitimate medical reason for using the drug.

MOTION: Dr. Donald made a motion to assess and accept costs of \$22,000 made payable in 2 years with a minimum of \$11,000 to be paid in the first year. The motion was seconded by Dr. Kleponis and carried 4/0.

MOTION FOR BOARD'S FINAL ORDER BY VOLUNTARY RELINQUISHMENT

3. Gregory Dean King, PTA (Case No. 2021-22637) (PCP- Waived)

Respondent was not present nor represented by counsel.

Ms. Harden summarized the case for the Board. Respondent was charged with the following violation: **Count I:** 456.072 (1)(c), Florida Statutes (2020) subjects a physical therapist to discipline for being convicted or found guilty of or entering a plea of guilty or nolo contendere to, regardless of adjudication, a crime in any jurisdiction which relates to the practice of, or the ability to practice, a licensee's profession. **Count II:** 456.072 (1)(x), Florida Statutes (2020) subjects a physical therapist to discipline for failing to report to the board, or the department if there is no board, in writing within 30 days after the licensee has been convicted or found guilty of, or entered a plea of nolo contendere to, regardless of adjudication, a crime in any jurisdiction. Convictions, findings, adjudications, and pleas entered into prior to the enactment of this paragraph must be reported in writing to the board, or department if there is no board, on or before October 1, 1999.

Respondent was charged with the following violation: Count I: 456.072 (1)(q), Florida Statutes (2017) subjects a licensee to discipline for violating a lawful order of the department or board or failing to comply with a lawfully issued subpoena of the department.

MOTION: Mr. Chenoweth made a motion to accept the investigative report into evidence. The motion was seconded by Dr. Donald and carried 4/0.

MOTION: Mr. Chenoweth made a motion to find that the Respondent was properly served and waived the right to a formal hearing. The motion was seconded by Dr. Donald and carried 4/0.

**5. Joseph A. Olivier, PTA
(Case No. 2019-52008)
(PCP- Chenoweth, Tasso and Candela)**

Respondent was not present nor represented by counsel.

Mr. Chenoweth was recused due to participation in the probable cause panel.

Ms. Harden summarized the case for the Board. Respondent was charged with the following violation: **Count I:** 486.125 (1)(e), Florida Statutes (2019) provides that failing to maintain acceptable standards of physical therapy practice as set forth by the board in rules adopted pursuant to this chapter constitutes grounds for discipline. Rule 64B17-6.001(2)(c), Florida Administrative Code, requires a physical therapist to avoid acts which blatantly disregard a patient's modesty. Rule 64B17-6.001(2)(f), Florida Administrative Code, requires a physical therapist to practice physical therapy with that level of care, skill, and treatment which is recognized by a reasonably prudent similar physical therapy practitioner as being acceptable under similar conditions and circumstances. Based on the foregoing, Respondent violated section 486.125(1)(e), through a violation of rules 64B17-6.001(2)(c) and/or (f).

Count II: 486.125(1)(k), Florida Statutes, subjects a licensee to discipline for violating any provision of this chapter or chapter 456, or any rules adopted pursuant thereto. Rule 64B17-6.001(3)(h), Florida Administrative Code; requires physical therapists to keep written medical records justifying the course of treatment of the patient, including, but not limited to, initial physical therapy assessment, plan of treatment, treatment notes, progress notes, examination results, test results, and discharge summary. Based on the foregoing, Respondent violated section 486.125(1)(k), through a violation of rule 64B17-6.001(3)(h).

MOTION: Dr. Pabian made a motion to accept the investigative report into evidence. The motion was seconded by Dr. Donald and carried 4/0.

MOTION: Dr. Pabian made a motion to find that the Respondent was properly served and waived the right to a formal hearing. The motion was seconded by Dr. Donald and carried 4/0.

MOTION: Dr. Pabian made a motion to adopt the findings of fact as set forth in the Administrative Complaint. The motion was seconded by Dr. Donald and carried 4/0.

MOTION: Dr. Pabian made a motion to adopt the conclusions of law as set forth in the Administrative Complaint and find that this constitutes a violation of the Chapters 486 and 456, Florida Statutes. The motion was seconded by Dr. Donald and carried 4/0.

MOTION: After discussion, Dr. Donald made a motion with the following aggravating factors: Danger to the public where the patient was in a vernerable population and Dr. Oliver's practicing in the profession since 1990; a motion was made to impose the following:

**6. Karina Andrea Nieto-Antonione, PTA
(Case No. 2021-27484)
(PCP- Chenoweth, Tasso and Candela)**

Respondent was not present nor represented by counsel.

Mr. Chenoweth was recused due to participation in the probable cause panel.

Ms. Harden summarized the case for the Board. Respondent was charged with the following violation: **Count I:** 456.072 (1)(II), Florida Statutes (2019) subjects a physical therapist to discipline for being convicted of or entering a plea of guilty or nolo contendere to, any misdemeanor or felony, regardless of adjudication, a crime in any jurisdiction which relates to health care fraud. **Count II:** 456.072(1) (kk), Florida Statutes (2021), subjects a licensee to discipline for being terminated from the state Medicaid program pursuant to s. 409.913, any other state Medicaid program, or the federal Medicare program, unless eligibility to participate in the program from which the practitioner was terminated has been restored.

MOTION: Dr. Pabian made a motion to accept the investigative report into evidence. The motion was seconded by Dr. Koenig and carried 4/0.

MOTION: Dr. Pabian made a motion to find that the Respondent was properly served and waived the right to a formal hearing. The motion was seconded by Dr. Koenig and carried 4/0.

MOTION: Dr. Pabian made a motion to adopt the findings of fact as set forth in the Administrative Complaint. The motion was seconded by Dr. Koenig and carried 4/0.

MOTION: Dr. Pabian made a motion to adopt the conclusions of law as set forth in the Administrative Complaint and find that this constitutes a violation of the Chapters 486 and 456, Florida Statutes. The motion was seconded by Dr. Koenig and carried 4/0.

MOTION: After discussion, Dr. Pabian made a motion to impose the following penalties:

- \$20,000 in administrative fines

PETITION FOR WAIVER OF RULE & CONSIDERATION OF APPLICATION FOR LICENSURE BY ENDORSEMENT AS A PHYSICAL THERAPIST

18. Bartlomiej Karol Roman, PT by Endorsement

Mr. Roman was present.

Mr. Roman has petitioned the Board for variance and waiver of Rule 64B17-3.001, F.A.C.

Mr. Roman is requesting that the FCCPT evaluation used by the New York Physical Therapy Board be accepted to satisfy the requirements.

Board staff received his first official FCCPT credential evaluation on January 31, 2022.

On February 3, 2022, Board Staff received a revised evaluation.

Staff received a petition on February 15, 2022.

Mr. Roman requested to withdraw his petition and application at this time.

PERSONAL APPEARANCE PURSUANT TO §456.013(3)(c), F.S.

8. Jack Wesley Boling, PT by Endorsement

Mr. Boling was present.

Mr. Boling was sent a notice to appear for the May meeting on March 22, 2022.

MOTION: After discussion, Dr. Donald made a motion to deny Mr. Boling's application for licensure. The motion was seconded by Mr. Chenoweth and carried 5/0.

9. Mary Elizabeth Naylor, PT by Endorsement

Ms. Naylor was present.

Ms. Naylor's probation has been terminated in Maryland and her license is currently active. Ms. Naylor was noticed on March 30, 2022.

MOTION: After discussion, Dr. Donald made a motion to approve Ms. Naylor's application for licensure and to certify her to sit for the Florida Laws and Rules Exam and upon a passing score on the exam she shall be licensed. The motion was seconded by Dr. Pabian and carried 5/0.

10. George Olson, PT by Endorsement

Mr. Olson was not present.

The Board Chair required Mr. Olson's appearance at the February 11, 2022, meeting, in which he was not in attendance. On March 2, 2022, he received an Order Requiring his Appearance at the May 20, 2022, meeting.

MOTION: After discussion, Dr. Pabian made a motion to vacate the previous order requiring appearance. The motion was seconded by Mr. Chenoweth and carried 5/0

MOTION: After discussion, Dr. Pabian made a motion to approve Mr. Olson's request to withdraw. The motion was seconded by Dr. Kleponis and carried 5/0

11. Vladislav Shut, PT by Endorsement

Mr. Shut was present.

Applicant appeared at the January 11, 2022, meeting, where he waived the 90-day requirement to stop Board Action.

Mr. Shut was requested by the Board to provide documentation regarding completing a course to satisfy his requirements with the Board of California. His presence was not required in May.

MOTION: After discussion, Dr. Pabian made a motion to approve Mr. Shut's application for licensure and to certify him to sit for the Florida Laws and Rules Exam and upon a passing score on the exam she shall be licensed. The motion was seconded by Dr. Kleponis and carried 5/0.

12. Mariecris Antoniette Somerville, PT by Examination

Ms. Somerville was present.

Ms. Somerville was offered a Settlement in New Jersey in lieu of Filing a Formal Disciplinary Complaint. She signed the offer on September 15, 2017. Board staff cannot determine if she met all requirements of her settlement agreement.

MOTION: After discussion, Dr. Pabian made a motion to approve Ms. Somerville's application for licensure and to certify her to sit for Florida Laws and Rules Exam, upon passing scores for both exams she shall be licensed. The motion was seconded by Dr. Donald and carried 5/0.

13. Heidi Gonzales-Negron, PT by Endorsement

Ms. Gonzales-Negron was not present.

While Board staff received a credential evaluation, it does not meet the requirements of our rule. Staff reached out to the applicant regarding the rule language and requirements for a Florida license.

The applicant has requested the Board to review her file "as is" on April 28, 2022.

MOTION: After discussion, Dr. Donald made a motion to require her appearance at the next meeting. The motion was seconded by Dr. Pabian and carried 5/0.

14. Maria Alejandra Fumero Mendoza, PT by Examination

Ms. Fumero Mendoza was present.

Board staff received an IERF evaluation for Ms. Fumero Mendoza. According to International Education Research Foundation (IERF), her combined studies are substantially equivalent to a physical therapy education program accredited by CAPTE in the United States. IERF confirms, the evaluation is for the purpose of physical therapy licensure only.

Ms. Fumero Mendoza confirmed via email, the FSBPT is not allowing her to register as physical therapist. Based on FSBPT's assessment of her school and her education, she is a physical therapist assistant.

Board staff contacted FSBPT staff via phone on April 28, 2022, and spoke with Lisa Singleton who confirms, based FSBPT's data the applicant graduated from a physical therapist assistant program and cannot register as a PT.

MOTION: After discussion, Dr. Pabian made a motion to approve Ms. Fumero Mendoza to sit for the National Physical Therapy Examination and the Florida Laws and Rules Exam, upon passing scores for both exams she shall be licensed as well as provide a letter to FSBPT to allow testing as a PT. The motion was seconded by Dr. Kleponis and carried 5/0.

15. Quinn Leslie Antonio Fairley, PTA by Examination

Mr. Fairley was not present.

Board staff received an FCCPT evaluation for Mr. Quinn Fairley. According to FCCPT, his education lacks the required course content in general and professional education.

General Education Required

- Physical Science-One Semester course in Physics (with laboratory)

Professional Education Required

- Basic Health Science-Genetics
- Clinical Education- Two Clinical Internships Total of 1050 Hours
- Evaluation-Findings the warrant referral
- Plan of Care Implementation- Interventions: Mechanical Agents; Interventions: Wound Debridement; Supervision of support staff; Discharge or Discontinuation; Patient-Related Emergency Procedures.

The applicant did not respond to the waiver option.

After discussion, Dr. Pabian requested to require his appearance at the next scheduled meeting.

16. Justin Lee Gochenauer, PTA by Examination

Mr. Gochenauer was not present.

Mr. Gochenauer's previous Florida license was revoked, and he was ordered to pay a \$10,000 fine within 18 months of the filing of the Final Order.

Mr. Gochenauer paid all costs and fines of his 2018 order on August 23, 2021.

MOTION: After discussion, Dr. Pabian made a motion to deny Mr. Gochenauer's application for licensure. The motion was seconded by Dr. Donald and carried 5/0.

17. Jennifer Ann Lopez Sattan, PTA by Examination

Ms. Lopez Sattan was not present.

Ms. Lopez Sattan was noticed due to having affirmative "Yes" answers to the criminal history questions on the application.

After discussion, Dr. Pabian requested to require her appearance at the next meeting.

NATIONAL PHYSICAL THERAPY EXAMINATION APPEAL FORM

19. Luigi Alred Nerona

Mr. Nerona was not present.

Mr. Nerona has unsuccessfully passed the NPTE exam receiving two (2) scores under 400.

He is no longer eligible to register for the NPTE exam due to FSBPT policies.

He is requesting that the Board grant his appeal to continue testing.

MOTION: After discussion, Dr. Pabian made a motion to approve Mr. Nerona's request to continue testing. The motion was seconded Dr. Kleponis and carried 5/0.

Mr. Heine was present and represented by counsel, Rickey Strong, Esq.

Provided with the application, documents from Michigan State Police, Township of Flint Police Department, City of Mustang Police Department, Michigan 97th District Court, Michigan 67th District Court, and City of Mustang public records offices confirm that no record(s) exist.

Mr. Heine's license is Clear/Active, with an expiration date of November 30, 2023.

- a. Be sent to the Board directly from the educational institution,
- b. Be presented on official school letterhead,
- c. Confirm that the individual completed all clinical and didactic requirements of their specified degree,
- d. State the date the individual earned their degree, and
- e. Be signed and dated by the program director or the school registrar.

The Board requested staff with the Chair to send letters to schools regarding proper letters of completion and correspondence to Program Directors.

31. Board Letter to PTA Programs

Dear Physical Therapist Assistant Program Directors,

The Florida Board of Physical Therapy would like to call your attention to a matter of concern at recent board meetings.

According to Florida Statute 486.015, the legislative intent of the Board is “to ensure that every physical therapy practitioner practicing in this state meets minimum requirements for safe practice.” The powers and duties of the Board of physical therapy (486.025) include the following statement: “The board may also review the standing and reputability of any school or college offering courses in physical therapy and whether the courses of such school or college in physical therapy meet the standards established by the appropriate accrediting agency ... In determining the standing and reputability of any such school and whether the school and courses meet such standards, the board may investigate and personally inspect the school and courses.”

Upon reviewing the data provided to the Board regarding the Florida Laws and Rules Examination, the Board believes the performance of graduates of physical therapist assistant (PTA) programs from Florida has been below acceptable standards. In 2021, the first-time pass rate for the graduates of PTA programs from Florida was 64%, with the overall pass rate for these graduates being 67%. Notably, this first attempt pass rate is over 11% lower than the first attempt PTA national licensure examination pass rate and 23% lower than the first attempt laws and rules exam in the performance of Florida physical therapy education programs graduates.

As stated, the Board believes that this level of pass rate performance is not acceptable and is drawing some concern for the preparation of PTA graduates to practice within the guidelines of Florida law safely and effectively. This letter intends to call your attention to this matter and ask that your institution makes a good-faith effort to enhance the preparation of your PTA graduates. The Board would like to see them succeed in this exam more readily and effectively and ensure that your graduates are safe and effective health care practitioners.
